

## Setting up Flickr

Flickr is a photo sharing tool that has rich functionality and allows the public to share their photographs with others. It allows educators to publish photographs of research materials, field trips and educational gatherings. Its photo tagging and annotation features also allows teachers to test the knowledge of students on specific topics. It is an excellent component of the Web 2.0 suite of tools.

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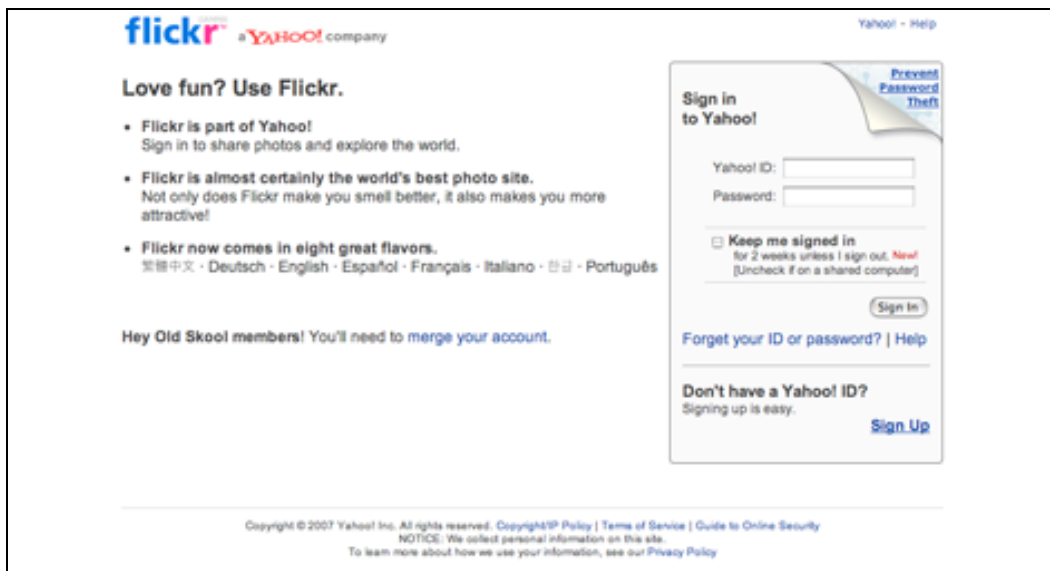
### Setting up a Flickr account

Open a web browser such as Internet Explorer and type this url in the address bar.

<http://flickr.com/> Your browser will take you to this page.



Click on the **Create Your Account** button. You will be taken to this screen.



If you already have a Yahoo account then simply sign in otherwise click on **Sign Up** in the bottom right hand corner and create a Yahoo account. When you sign up you will see this screen.

### Why am I being asked for my password?

- To protect your account, you need to confirm your password periodically. Some Yahoo! services, such as Yahoo! Mail and Yahoo! Address Book, require you to periodically enter your password even though you are already signed in. We do this to protect your personal information. You can adjust the length of time before password prompting—up to two weeks—by visiting [Account Info](#) and clicking on the [Edit](#) link for Member Information. ([more](#))
- For your security, we will always prompt you for your password when accessing sensitive personal information, like [Account Info](#).
- Only one account can be signed in at a time. If you're not "webtwoworkshop," [sign in with your own ID](#).

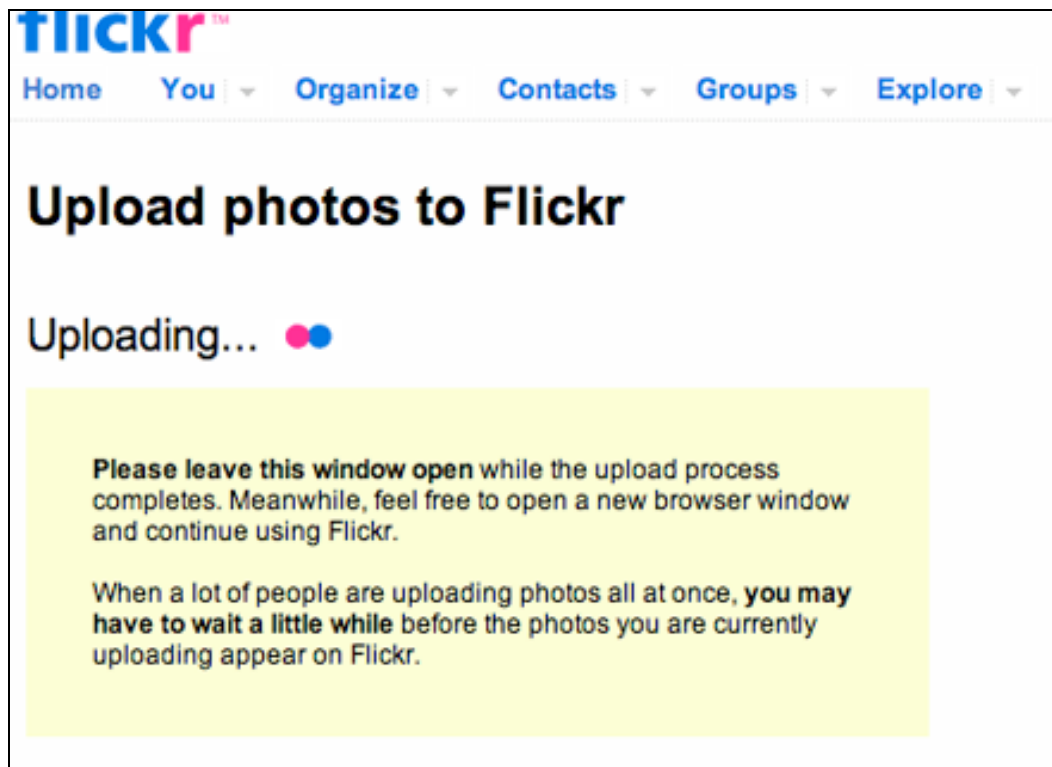

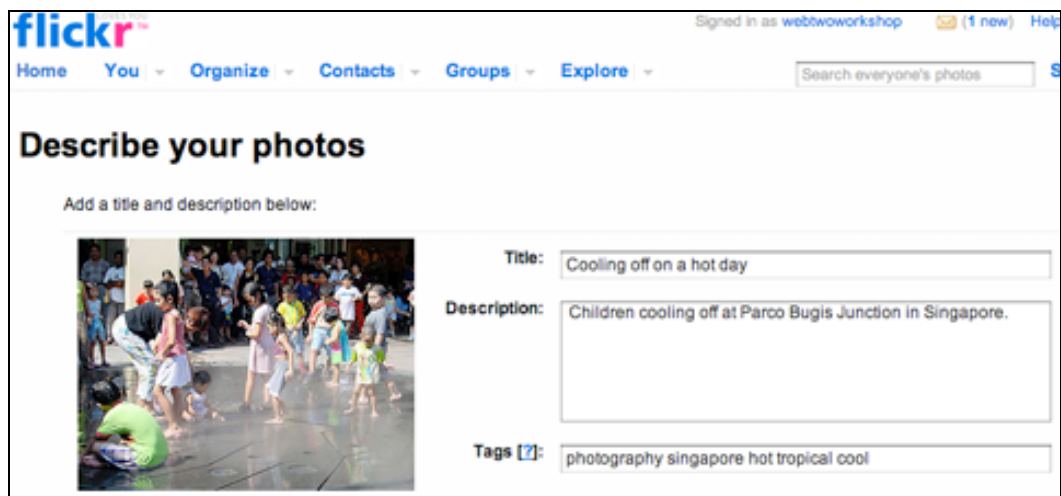
### Uploading tools

We provide tools for Mac and Windows to make it easy to upload a batch of photos all at once.

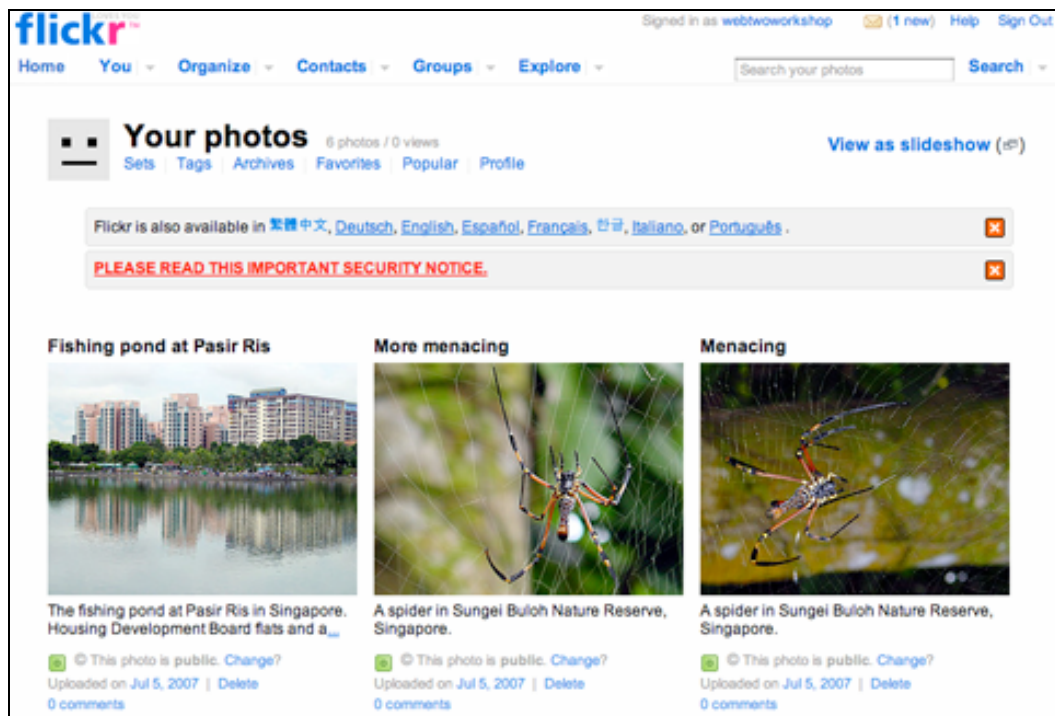
Once you have browsed to the photographs and selected them for upload decide whether they will be **private** or **public** and then click **Upload**. You will be taken to this screen.



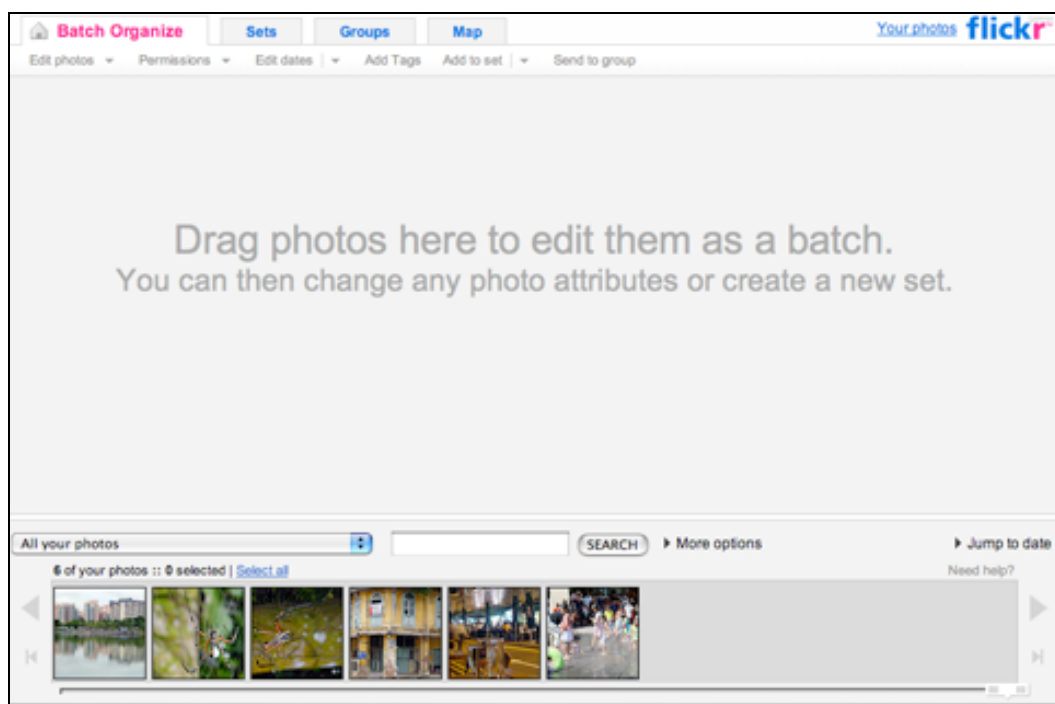
When the photographs have uploaded they will appear on the following screen.



Add a title, description and tag to each photograph and then click **Save**. You will be taken to this screen.

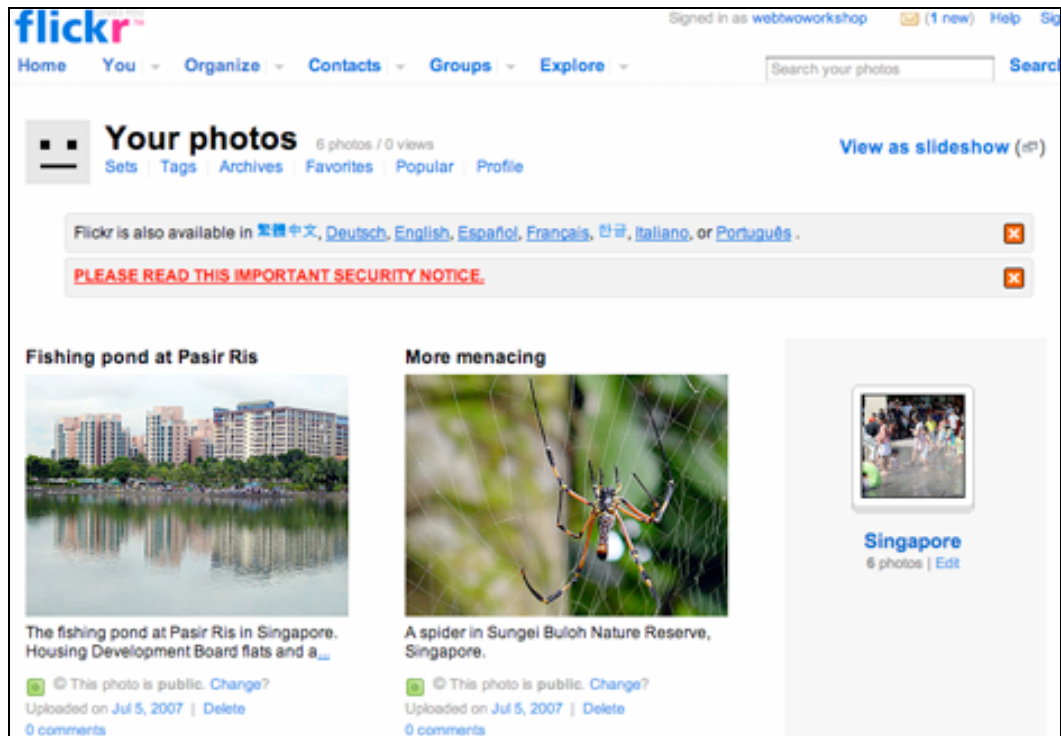


You can now organise your photographs by creating sets for example. Click on **Sets** to organise the photographs. You will be taken to this screen.

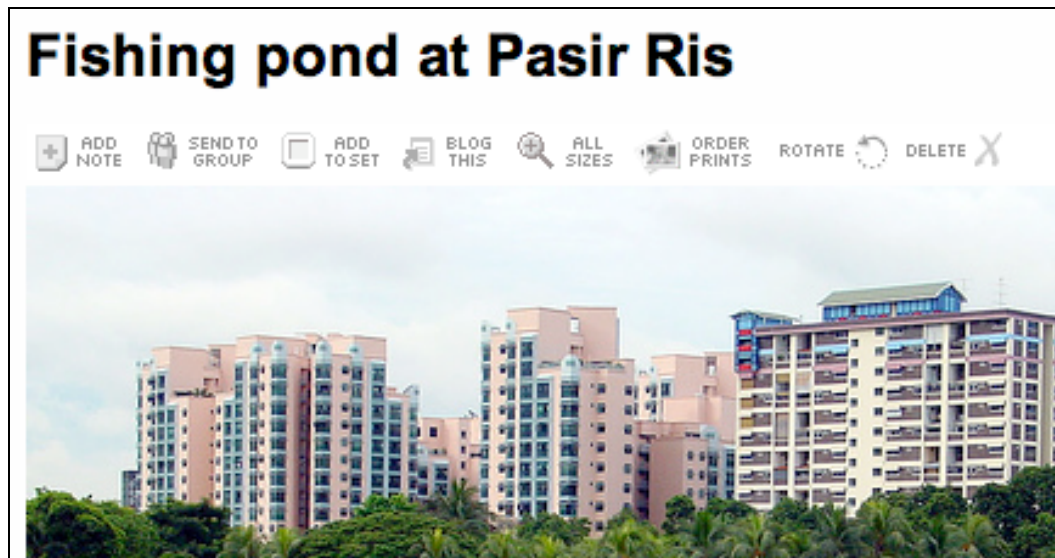


Follow the instructions on screen. Once you have finished the sets will be listed on your Flickr page.





Click one of your photographs. Look closely at the example below. You will notice that each photograph has a range of buttons situated above.

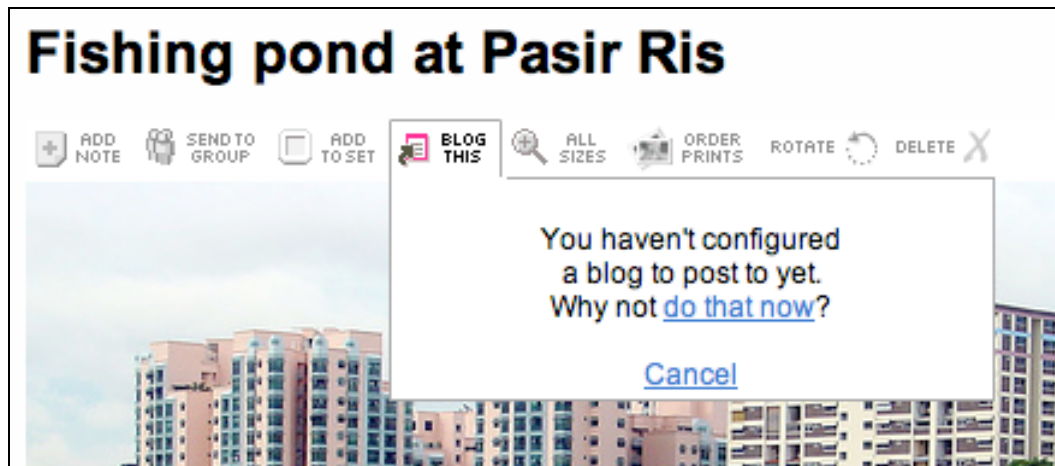


- Add Note:** Great for annotating parts of a photograph.
- Send To Group:** Forward the photograph to a specific group of people.
- Add To Set:** Add the photograph to a set.
- Blog This:** Add the photograph to your blog.
- All Sizes:** View the various sizes of images.
- Order Prints:** Order copies of the image.
- Rotate:** Rotate the image.
- Delete:** Remove the image.

Click on the **Blog This** button. You will see the following screen.



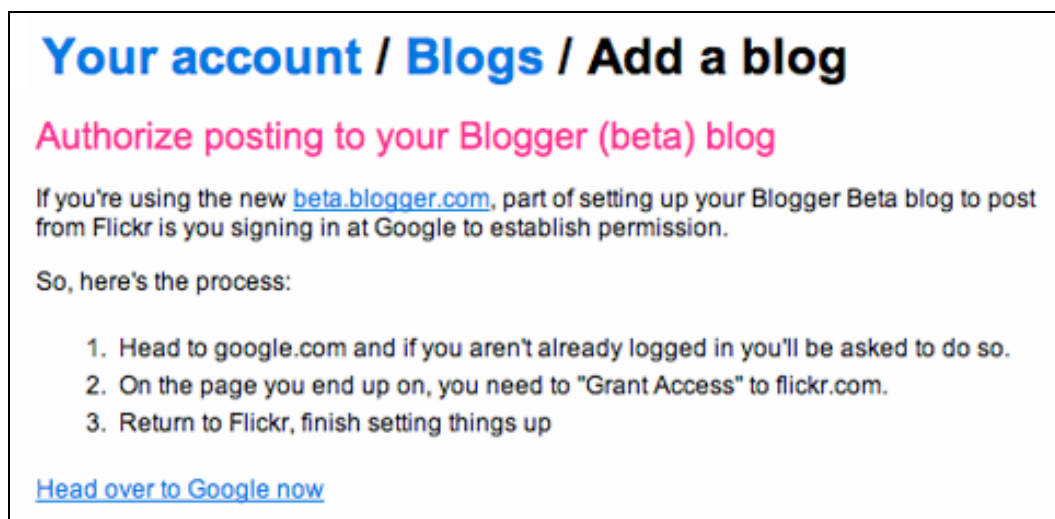

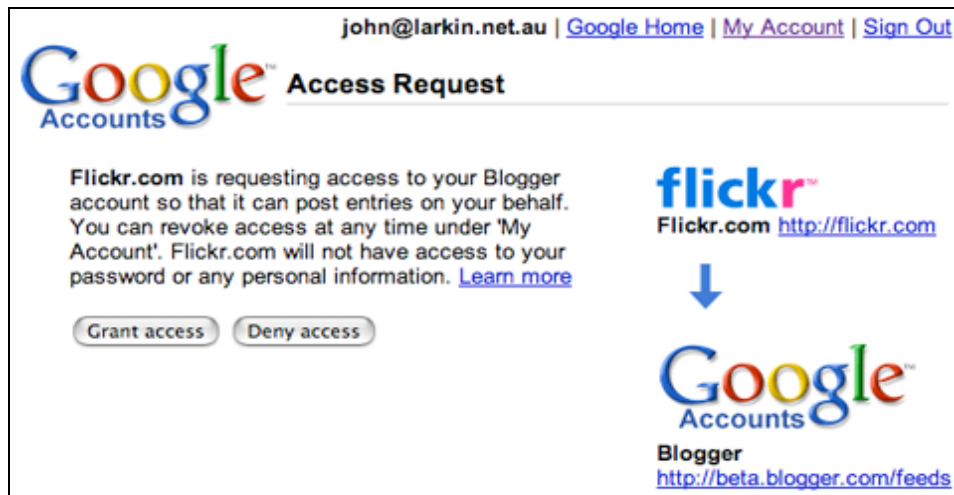
Click on “**do that now**”. You will see the following screen.



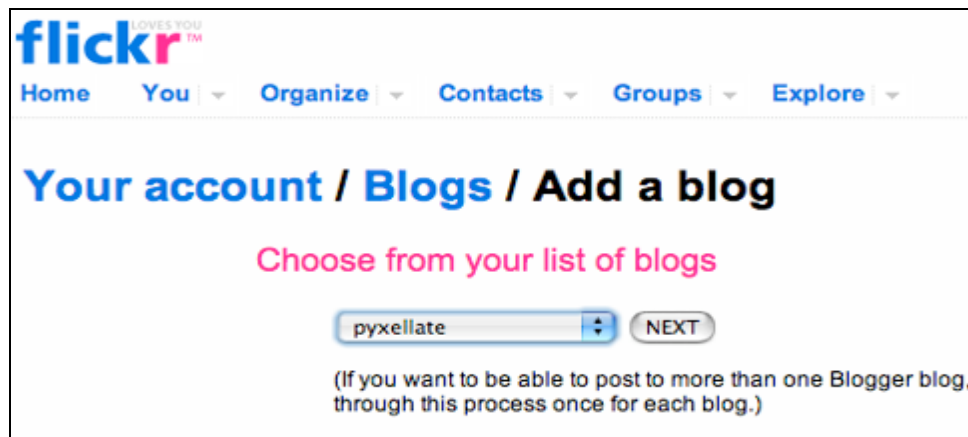
Click on **Next**. You will see the following screen.

Click on **Grant access now**. You will see the following screen.

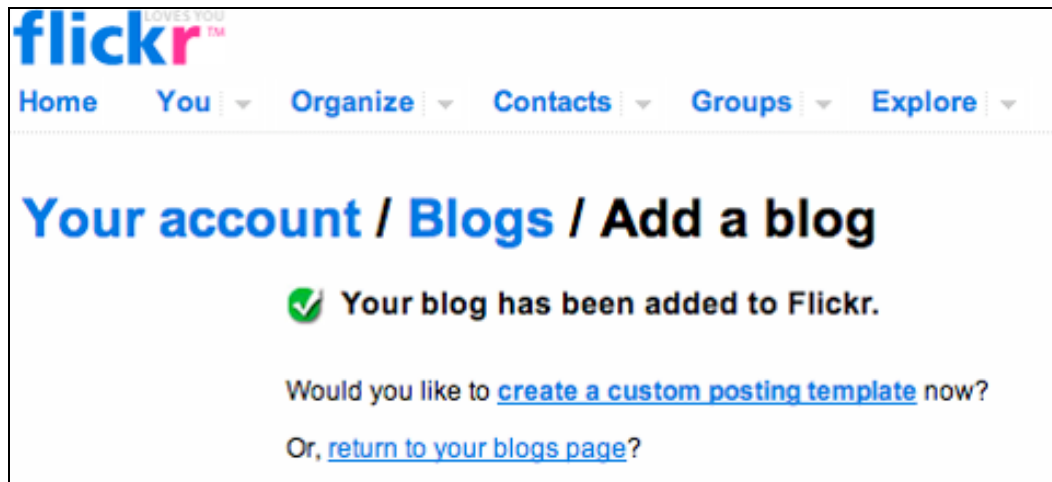


Select your new blog. Click on **Next**. You will see the following screen.

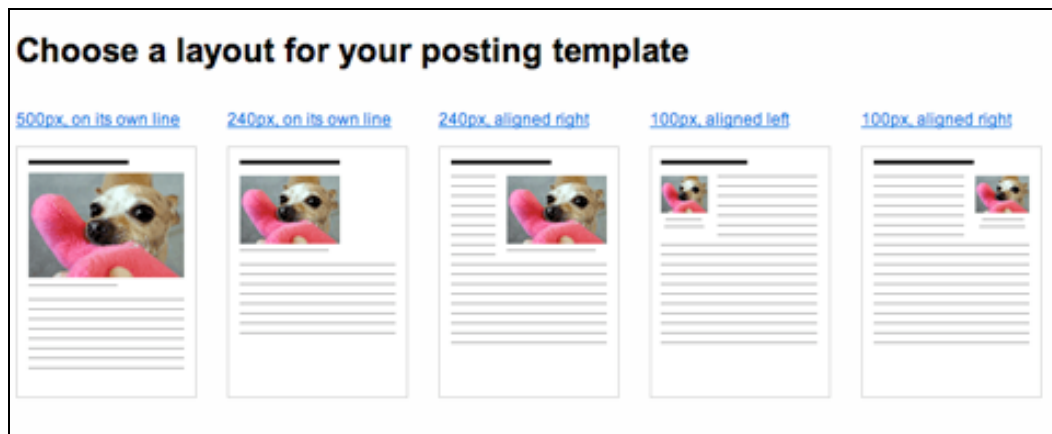


Click on **All Done** after checking the details. You will see the following screen.





Click on **Create a custom posting template**. You will see the following screen.



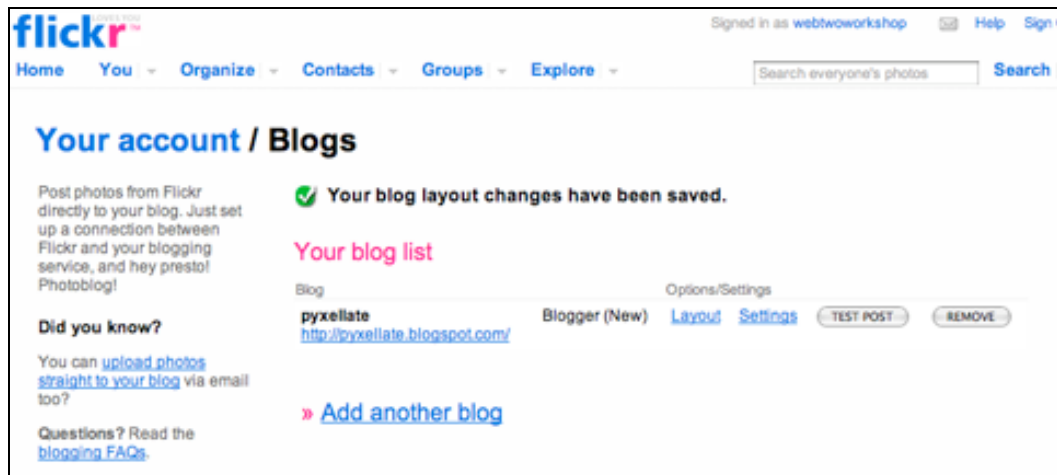
Click on **one** of the five **layouts**. You will see the following screen.
